Full papers must be submitted by December 10, 2004 and will be reviewed by the members of the Scientific Committee.

Notification of acceptance, or not, will be provided by January 31, 2005
The abstracts of accepted papers will be posted on the forthcoming website of the colloquium (http://www.edc.uoc.gr/4colloquium).

The Proceedings will be available after the Colloquium and hard copies will be sent to all participants via ordinary mail. Alike the previous three colloquia, the proceedings will be disposed to a large number of individuals and institutions outside Greece ${ }^{1}$. The papers of the presentations can be written in one of the following languages: Greek, English, or French.
